Meadowgrove Club swim and tennis

Meadowgrove Club reserves the right to eject anyone from the pool either permanently or temporarily and suspend membership privileges to anyone who does not adhere to the following rules.

Pool:

- 1. When no lifeguard is on duty, **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK**. The Hold Harmless Agreement is in effect.
- 2. The pool is open from dawn to dusk **Note:** The Pool is reserved for Lap swimming from dawn to 10 am (18+years old)
- 3. Access code(s) are not to be shared. Providing access codes to non-members will result in the suspension of membership privileges.
- 4. Members 14 years and up are permitted to use the pool unaccompanied by an adult during non-lifeguard hours
- 5. Kids below 14 years of age are not permitted to be at the pool without adult supervision.
- 6. When a lifeguard is present, children 10 and older who have passed a swim test may swim without an adult present. <u>Lifeguards are not babysitters</u>. For swim test details, visit www.meadowgroveclub.com
- Minors cannot bring guests 16 and under unless an adult/parent/ guardian/lifeguard is present. (For a babysitter bringing your child, email: www.membership@meadowgroveclub.com)
- 8. Minors cannot use Clubhouse as a hang-out place without an adult present.
- 9. No running, pushing, profanity, or horseplay is permitted in or around the pool. Members and guests may be expelled for inappropriate conduct
- 10. Diving is only allowed in the deep end of the pool. (12 feet area)
- 11. No glass containers on the pool deck
- 12. Food or drink is not permitted in the pool
- 13. Smoking/Vaping is not permitted within the gated pool area, nor in front of pool gate
- 14. Pets are not permitted within the gated pool area or the tennis courts
- 15. Radios must be kept at a respectful volume. Surrounding homeowners should be taken into consideration
- 16. When present, **Lifeguards are in complete charge** of bathers in and around the pool and may impose additional rules as needed. Do not distract lifeguards
- 17. When lifeguards are absent, Meadowgrove Club officers/board members may act as interpreters of the rules

- 18. When lifeguards are present, there will be 10 minutes of each hour for adults only ("**Adult Swim**"). During Adult Swim, only those 18 and older are allowed in the pool. Children are not allowed on the steps, and no arms or legs are allowed in the pool.
- 19. In the event of **thunder or lightning, all bathers must exit the pool**. Only after a period of 20 minutes without thunder and lightning may bathers re-enter pool
- 20. Clean up after yourself and your guests. Pick up trash and leave furniture in an orderly manner, lower umbrellas before leaving
- 21. Non-potty trained children must wear a swim diaper. The Club must be notified at membership@meadowgroveclub.com if a fecal accident occurs, after which the pool must be closed for treatment.
- 22. DO NOT LEAVE DIRTY DIAPERS IN THE BATHROOM TRASH CANS
- 23. **LOST & FOUND**: Items will be placed at the lifeguard stand or hung in the clubhouse. Items will be disposed of on Sundays.
- 24. Parking is not permitted by the clubhouse with only the following exceptions:
 - 1. You have a valid handicapped parking permit
 - 2. You are a contractor or member that has equipment or delivery (other than children) to make
 - 3. You are a lifeguard, coach, or county referee reporting for your official shift
 - 4. You have a broken or sprained leg,

Please do not drive by the tennis courts when the ball is in play, and please watch for people and drive very slowly.

Violation of rules:

The violator will first be given a verbal warning. If the violations continue, the person will be directed to either sit out of the pool or leave the premises. If a person refuses to leave the premises when directed, the police will be contacted for assistance.

Repeated failure to comply with club rules will result in the loss of club privileges.

1 Offense: Expulsion for the day2 Offense: Expulsion for one week

3 Offense: Privileges suspended until Board meets

Individuals will be brought to the Board for action. For consistent enforcement, the lifeguard will make a written report on improper behavior and disciplinary action taken.

Tennis court rules and etiquette:

- 1. Tennis courts are to be used by Meadowgrove members and their guests for tennis only. All guests must be playing on the same court with their host member. The only exception to this is usage by approved Non-Member "Practice Teams and/or League Teams" which should be set up by a Tennis court Administrator
- Reservations must be made via <u>reservemycourt.com</u> (RMC) A printed confirmation or smartphone with RMC access will assure you of a court. This is the sole source for resolving conflicts
- 3. Only 1 court may be reserved at a time per member (*exception: paid team practice*) and no back to back reservations by the same member are allowed
- 4. Please be on time for your reservation. There will be a 15-minute grace period after the start of the reservation. The court can then be reserved by another player.
- 5. Sign-up duration will be for 2 hours or less, except for scheduled league matches. League matches may retain the signed-up court until the league match is completed.
- 6. When play is completed, players must clean up/empty trash into green trash cans next to the wooden fence and turn off the lights. Trash liner bags are located in the storage bin by the light switches. (see photo below)
- 7. Teams playing and/or practicing at Meadowgrove tennis courts must have a current "Team Registration/Contract" on file with the club. All Non-Member Fees must be collected by the Team Captain and turned into the Treasurer (Meadowgrove Club Inc., Box 672461, Marietta GA 30006) prior to the first scheduled team practice with a complete team roster. (\$35 per non-member, per season for each team)
- 8. Teams are allowed to reserve 3 tennis courts for their match day. If there are two teams playing home match on same day, each team will use two tennis courts.
- 9. Non-members who participate on a Meadowgrove League Team or Practice Team are entitled to participate in one scheduled practice per week (two courts) and home matches. Non-Members are NOT permitted to use the courts at other times.
- 10. Members who are found to reserve courts or practice "blocking" of courts with numerous reservations and not use or cancel them will be warned when first observed, and then reservation privileges removed for a month if this continues
- 11. To avoid undue wear, no dogs, skateboards, or skates are allowed on the courts.
- 12. Players must observe proper tennis etiquette. No abusive language, physical threats, or physical force will be tolerated.
- 13. Pickleball can be played on Court #2 where the lines are painted. DO NOT lower the net strap though as they are hard to adjust back and forth. Also please do not leave tape / temp nets on the courts or they will be removed.
- 14. Courts are blown off each Friday but if you need a blower there is one available in the locker make sure to secure it and charge batteries (see below). Brooms and court rollers are available. Please hang rollers under the protective covers after use by the Frame so the roller is not compressed where the hooks are.
